## CALL FOR PROJECTS TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

Dear Interested Parties or Agencies:

The Inyo County Local Transportation Commission (LTC) is pleased to issue a Call for Projects for the Transportation Enhancement Program (TE). The amount allocated to Inyo County for the 2012 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) cycle is estimated to be \$1,204,000. At their August 2011 meeting, the California Transportation Commission will determine the exact amount available. An 11.47% local match is required for all projects. Please note that the majority of new funding will be in the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 fiscal years.

The application can be downloaded from <http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/transprog/ocip/2012stip.htm> by following the link under 2012 TE Information or it can be obtained by contacting Inyo LTC staff at (760) 878-0201. Preliminary applications should be submitted to the Caltrans District 9 Local Assistance Office to determine if the project is eligible before submitting it to the LTC. Additionally, a letter of intent from an eligible sponsor should be submitted to the LTC as part of your application package.

Eligibility requirements, tips for a successful application, and procedures for submitting and evaluating applications used by the LTC are included as attachments to this letter.
