Hello,

This afternoon (10/18) at approximately 5:15 p.m. I observed an OHV entering State Route 168 at Starlite Road and traveling east at a relatively high rate of speed on the highway. While this vehicle had a rear license plate for another state (Utah?) it did not appear street legal for California. Perhaps I am mistaken regarding the appropriate use of this vehicle on the highway; a couple of photos are attached.

In early June on another Sunday afternoon at roughly 4 p.m. a red Polaris crossed U.S. 395 just north of Ed Powers Road and then headed east on a dirt road paralleling the highway. That vehicle was definitely not street legal and was not operated in accordance with AB 628.
